

Final Flexion Wrap^m

Use to restore final degrees of PIP & DIP joint flexion. Monitor vascularity closely when applying Final Flexion Wrap to prevent ischemia. Final Flexion Wraps (FFW) may be applied by one of two methods.

Method One



Wrap around finger with the broad section on the proximal phalanx and narrow section on the distal phalanx.



Adjust tension and secure hook closure.

Method Two



Thread end of the FFW through the buttonhole to form a loop. Slip loop around proximal phalanx and fit securely.



Bring wrap around the distal phalanx, drawing finger into flexion. Secure hook closure.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS





Rinse or wash in cold water after use. Frequent washing will extend the life of your splint. Hand or machine wash, cold water, mild detergent. Air dry.

Do not place in dryer.

Material: Elastomeric foam, nylon, Lyrca. Contains no latex.

Storage: Store 3-Point soft splints in cool, dry place. Avoid temperatures above 80°Fahrenheit (26.66° Celsius).
